

Official Rules:

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KINDS IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN A PRIZE. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Program; Program Period

1. The Zevo & Walmart NFL Sweepstakes (the "**Program**") commences at 12:00:01 AM Eastern Time ("ET") on September 14, 2026, and ends at 11:59:59 PM ET on October 26, 2026 (the "**Program Period**"). All Entries must be submitted by 11:59:59 PM ET on October 26, 2026 (the "**Program Closing Time**"). Entries submitted after the Program Closing Time will not be accepted. The computer clock of Sponsor is the official time-keeping device in the Program, and the Sponsor may also rely on the time processing functions of third parties. Sponsor shall have the sole discretion in determining the timeliness of any action or inaction related to this Program.

The Program comprises a sweepstakes game of chance (the "Sweepstakes") consisting of a single grand prize drawing (the "**Grand Prize Drawing**") to be held at the end of the Program Period, as further set out in these Official Rules.

Sponsor

2. The Program is sponsored by Procter & Gamble (the "Sponsor"). The Sponsor's address is One Procter & Gamble Plaza, Cincinnati, OH 45202.

Eligible Persons

1. The Program is open only to individuals who: (a) are legal residents of one (1) of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia (the "Eligibility Area"); (b) 21 years of age or older at the time of entering the Program; (c) agree to be bound by the terms of these Official Rules; and (d) submit a valid Entry (as defined below) (each such individual, an "Entrant" or "you"). This Program is **not open** to Entrants who: (i) are employees, officers, directors, agents and representatives of (x) the Sponsor, or any other entity which is involved in any aspect of the creation, production, operation, execution or fulfillment of the Program on behalf of the Sponsor (such entities, collectively, the "Sponsor Parties") or (y) the National Football League, its member professional football clubs, NFL Ventures, Inc., NFL Ventures, L.P., NFL Properties LLC, NFL Enterprises LLC (such entities, collectively, the "NFL Entities"), and together with the Sponsor Entities, the "Released Parties"; (ii) are immediate families (defined as parents, child, sibling, domestic partner, spouse and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) or household members (defined as those people who share the same residence at least three (3) months a year) of such individuals listed in clause (i) above); (iii) are prohibited by applicable law from entering the Program; or (iv) do not meet any of the eligibility requirements set forth above.

3. An Entrant must meet the eligibility requirements set out in these Official Rules from the time of Entry until the time they are confirmed a winner, if applicable.

How To Enter

5.2. Mail-In to Enter Method.

Once your valid eligible Mail In Submission has been received in accordance with these Official Rules, you will receive one (1) Sweepstakes Entry.

OVERALL LIMITS

6. **Entry Limits. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in these Official Rules, each person/Entrant can earn a maximum of one (1) Sweepstakes Entry for the entire Program Period, regardless of method of entry.**

7. By participating through any Method, you agree to these Official Rules and to the decisions of the Sponsor and Program Administrator, which are final and binding in all respects.
8. Where you use a mobile device to access the Program, data rates may apply. Please consult with your mobile device service provider regarding rate plans.
9. Any available opt-in opportunities offered in connection with this Program are not required to Enter this Program, and checking any opt-in boxes will not improve your chances of winning.

Prizes

10. There is one grand prize available to be won in this Program (the "Grand Prize" or sometimes, a "Prize").
11. A person eligible to win a Prize must accept the Prize as awarded and may not transfer such Prize or substitute or exchange for, or apply the Prize's value towards, cash or a higher cost or an alternative prize. All Prizes are non-refundable, cannot be replaced if lost or stolen and are provided on an "as is" basis, without any representation or warranty of any kind. 12. The Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of any Prize is subject to change based upon current market conditions at the time of Prize fulfillment. Any difference between the ARV and the actual value, if any, will not be awarded. Limit one (1) Grand Prize per winner. All Prize details not specified in these Official Rules will be determined at the Sponsor's sole discretion. If for any reason a Prize is unavailable, Sponsor reserves the right to modify the Program in its sole discretion and award a substitute prize, or portion of a prize, of comparable or greater value as set forth in these Official Rules. No substitution, transfer, assignment or cash equivalent of a Prize, or any portion thereof, is permitted by a winner, except that Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a Prize of comparable or greater value in its sole discretion. The Sponsor Parties shall have no responsibility or obligation to a winner who is unable or unavailable to, or who does not for any reason, accept or utilize a Prize.
13. The value of a Prize may be taxable to the winner as income and an IRS Form 1099 and W9 may be issued in the name of the Winner for the actual value of the Prize awarded. All U.S. federal, state and local tax liability, and any other costs and expenses associated with acceptance or use of a Prize not specifically provided for in these Official Rules are solely the winner's responsibility. Failure to complete any component of any Prize does not relieve the Prize Winner of his/her tax obligations associated with winning such Prize.
14. Prize Limits. Each Entrant may win a maximum of one (1) Grand Prize during the Program.

Grand Prize and Odds of Winning

17. One (1) Grand Prize will be awarded pursuant to the Grand Prize Drawing described below. The Grand Prize consists of a trip for two (2) to attend the Super Bowl LXI in Inglewood, California taking place on or about February 14, 2027 (the "Trip"). 18. The ARV of **the Grand Prize** is approximately **\$12,950**. No difference between the actual and approximate **Grand Prize** value will be provided.
19. The odds of winning the Grand Prize depend on the total number of eligible Sweepstakes Entries received during the Program Period by the Program Closing Time.

Trip Conditions

Sponsor is not responsible if Trip is delayed, postponed, or canceled for any reason. **No refund or compensation will be paid in the event of the cancellation or delay of any portion of the Trip, or any portion thereof.**

21. In the event a Grand Prize Winner or their Guest engages in behavior that, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, is obnoxious or threatening, illegal or that is intended to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, Sponsor reserves the right to terminate the Trip early, in whole or in part, with no further obligation. In the event a Grand Prize Winner or their Guest engages in behavior that is, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, illegal, tortious, or subjects Grand Prize Winner or their guest to arrest or detention, Sponsor shall have no obligation to pay any damages, fees, fines, judgments or other costs or expenses of any kind whatsoever incurred by Grand Prize Winner or their guest as a result of such conduct. **NEITHER SPONSOR NOR ANY CONTEST ENTITY SHALL HAVE ANY LIABILITY FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURIES, DEATH, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR OTHER DAMAGES OR EXPENSES RESULTING FROM OR ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE GRAND PRIZE OR ANY ACTIVITY RELATED TO THE GRAND PRIZE OR ANY OTHER ASPECT OF GRAND PRIZE WINNER OR THEIR GUEST'S ACCEPTANCE OR USE OF THE GRAND PRIZE.** Prizing may be fulfilled by a third-party fulfillment agency. Grand Prize Drawing:

2. A single random draw to award the Grand Prize (the "Grand Prize Drawing"), subject to these Official Rules, will be held in Detroit, Michigan on or about November 5, 2026, from all eligible Sweepstakes Entries received during the Program Period, to select potential winners. The Grand Prize Drawing will be conducted by the Program Administrator.
22. Limit of one (1) Grand Prize per Entrant/person for the Program Period.
23. The Sponsor and/or its representatives may respond to entrants or otherwise engage with Program participants during the Program Period, but such interactions will have no impact on the process through which Prizes are awarded in accordance with these Rules.

Winner Notification

24. The potential winner of a Grand Prize will be notified initially by email sent to the Registered Email Address beginning within one (1) day of the date on which their Sweepstakes Entry was selected as a potential winner. If the Program Administrator is unsuccessful in its attempt to reach and communicate directly with a potential Grand Prize winner by email after one (1) attempt, then the Program Administrator will follow up with a phone call via the phone number provided on the potential winner's Sweepstakes Entry. If after two (2) phone outreach attempts over the course of two (2) days, the Program Administrator is unsuccessful in its attempts to reach and communicate with the potential

winner, at the Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion, that potential winner may be disqualified without liability to the Sponsor.

Winner Confirmation

3. The potential Grand Prize winner (and their Guest) will also be sent an Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability & Publicity Release, a Guest Affidavit and Release, and an IRS Form W-9/1099 (collectively, the "Winner Documentation"), and the potential winner will be required to submit to and pass a background check. The Winner Documentation must be duly completed, signed, and returned to Administrator in accordance with the Administrator's instructions within two (2) business days of date of issuance, or such other period as specified by the Administrator.
25. Provided that a potential winner is in compliance with these Official Rules and after having successfully proven eligibility and provided any documentation as may be required by the Program Administrator, the potential winner will be determined to be a Prize "Winner". If such potential winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, if the potential winner is ineligible, if the potential winner fails to return the duly completed Winner Documentation within the prescribed time period (if applicable), if any notification is returned undeliverable, or if the potential winner otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules, they will forfeit the Prize as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, and an alternate winner may be selected from among all remaining eligible Entries either through a process similar to the one that selected the original potential winner or through a random draw, the exact process to be determined by the Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion, subject to these Official Rules. and the process of confirming the winner will again be followed. This will be repeated until such time as a Prize winner is ultimately determined, unless the Sponsor determines in its reasonable discretion, after conducting at least three (3) alternate winner selections, that it is unlikely that a Prize Winner will be determined in which case the applicable Prize will remain un-awarded. Sponsor expressly reserves the right to delay the announcement of the Winner for any reason it deems necessary. Any disqualified winner will not receive any alternate prize, substitution or compensation.
26. If a selected potential winner does not meet the eligibility requirements, does not complete and return the Declaration and Release, is unable or unwilling to accept the Prize as offered or elects to decline the Prize, they may be disqualified at the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor and an alternate potential winner may be selected from among the remaining eligible Entries, either through a process similar to the one that selected the original potential winner or through a random draw, the exact process to be determined by the Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion, subject to these Rules.
27. Upon satisfaction of all requirements of these Official Rules, including, without limitation, receipt of the completed applicable Winner Documentation, winners will be contacted to make further Prize delivery arrangements.
4. Please allow six (6) to eight (8) weeks for delivery of any Prize.

Verification:

28. All Entries may be subject to verification at any time and for any reason. The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identification and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Sponsor, including, but not limited to, government-issued photo identification): (i) to verify an individual's eligibility to participate in this Program; (ii) to verify the eligibility and/or legitimacy of any Entry, submission and/or information submitted (or purportedly submitted) for the purposes of this Program; and/or (iii) for any other purpose that Sponsor deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the administration of this Program in accordance with Sponsor's interpretation of the letter and spirit of these Official Rules. Any person who fails to provide such proof to the complete

satisfaction of the Sponsor, within the time period specified by the Sponsor, may be disqualified from participating in this Program in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor

Without limiting the generality of the preceding, Entrants must comply with the following conditions, or they may be disqualified, and their Entry may be cancelled:

Privacy

29. The Sponsor respects your right to privacy and works at all times to comply with all applicable data protection and privacy laws. Except as expressly set out in these Official Rules, in the Sponsor's Privacy Policy (available at <https://privacypolicy.pg.com/en-US/#statePrivacyNotice>) or as otherwise agreed to by you, any personal information provided in connection with this Program will only be collected, used and disclosed by the Sponsor and its third party partners and service providers for the purposes of administering and conducting this Program, including, without limitation, verification of eligibility and identity and awarding and delivering Prizes. For information on how your personal information may be used by the Administrator, please read their privacy policy at: <https://www.snipp.com/privacy-policy>

30. Please note that personal information provided as part of this Program may be collected in, transferred to and processed and stored in jurisdictions outside of the United States. Such information will be subject to the general laws applicable within those jurisdictions, including, without limitation, possible access by regulatory authorities. The Sponsor will not sell, share or otherwise disclose personal information provided in connection with this Program to or with third parties or agents, other than to third parties or agents engaged by the Sponsor to administer the Program, fulfill prizes, or as otherwise permitted or required by applicable laws. This section does not limit any other consent(s) that an individual may provide the Sponsor or others in relation to the collection, use and/or disclosure of their personal information.

Release

31. By participating in this Program, you agree to release, discharge and hold harmless the Released Parties, and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents and assigns; and each of these companies' and individuals' respective successors, representatives and assigns from and against: (a) any claims, liabilities, losses, and damages arising out of, or relating to, your participation in this Program or any Program-related activities and the acceptance and use, misuse, or possession of any Prize awarded hereunder, including, without limitation, any misrepresentation made by you in connection with this Program; (b) any non-compliance by you with these Official Rules; (c) claims brought by persons or entities other than the parties to these Official Rules arising from or related to your involvement with this Program; (d) acceptance, possession, misuse or use of any prize or participation in Program-related activity or participation in this Program; (e) any malfunction, error or other problem arising in connection with the collection, processing, or retention of Entry information; or any typographical or other error in the printing, offering or announcement of any winner. The foregoing includes, without limitation, any claim for personal injury, property loss or damage, or death arising in any way in connection with this Program. 32. Without limiting the generality of the preceding release Participant irrevocably waives all claims against the NFL Entities and agrees that the NFL Entities will have no liability or responsibility for any claim arising in connection with participation in this Sweepstakes or the prizes awarded. The NFL Entities have not offered or sponsored this Sweepstakes in any way.

Additional Rules and Restrictions

33. If due to production, online, internet, computer or other error of any kind, more Prizes, in any category, are claimed than intended to be distributed or awarded according to these Official Rules, then, the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to rescind invalid Prize claims and/or conduct a random draw from amongst all eligible Prize claimants to award the correct number of Prizes in each category. In no event will the Sponsor be liable for more than the number of Prizes in any category as stated in these Official Rules.
34. By participating in this Program, Entrants agree to abide by and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor and the Program Administrator, which shall be final and binding on all Entrants in all matters relating to this Program. In the event an entrant wins a Prize and is later found to be in violation of these Rules, they will be required to forfeit the Prize or to reimburse Sponsor for the stated value of the Prize if such violation is discovered after winner has used the Prize. False, fraudulent or deceptive Entries or acts shall render entrants ineligible for the Prize.
35. Proof of sending Entry (regardless of Method) is not proof of receipt by the Sponsor or Program Administrator. Incomplete, altered, mutilated or garbled Entries will be disqualified. The Released Parties are not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, garbled, stolen, incomplete, invalid, unintelligible or damaged Entries, or for Entries submitted in a manner that is not expressly allowed under these Rules, or for any Entry not submitted or received due to any technical error or failure, unauthorized human intervention, inaccurate capture or mis-entry of any required information, the effects of hackers, the failure of any electronic equipment, computer transmissions and/or network connections or any other reason beyond Sponsor's reasonable control; all of which will be disqualified. The Released Parties are not responsible for mechanical, technical, electronic, communications, telephone, computer, hardware or software errors, malfunctions or failures of any kind, including, without limitation: failed, incomplete, garbled or delayed transmission of online Entries, traffic congestion on telephone lines, the Internet or at any website or lost or unavailable network connections which may limit an online entrant's ability to participate in the Program, and any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in or downloading any information necessary to participate in the Program. 36. The Released Parties are not responsible for the cancellation or postponement of any component of this Program or any associated programs and materials. The Released Parties are not responsible for typographical or other errors in the offer or administration of this Program, including, without limitation, errors which may occur in connection with the printing or advertising of this Program, these Official Rules, administration or execution of the Program, the conducting of the any Prize drawing or winner selection, the cancellation of any element of a Prize, the processing of Entries or in the selection or announcement of a Prize or Prize winner.
